In September of 2017, Katie was told that her [#leukemia](#) was back. She had originally been diagnosed in 2015, and had been in remission after a bone marrow transplant. Since she had already had a transplant, she was informed of another option that may be more successful for her relapse. The therapy is Car-T and is a new [#treatment](#) that uses your own T-Cells to fight the [#cancer](#). On January 9, Katie received her re-engineered T-Cells to [#fight](#) off the leukemia and on Tuesday of this week, Katie had a procedure to see if the new therapy had been successful. On Wednesday, February 7, she and her family were notified that Katie was, once again cancer free!

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
